## Advertisement No. 4/2010

Applications in the prescribed format given below are invited from Indian Citizens and such other nationals as are declared eligible by Govt. of India for recruitment to the undermentioned posts. Posts at Serial. No. 1, 3, 4, 5, 7, 8, 10, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 19, 20, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27 are permanent. All other posts are temporary (likely to be permanent). The number of vacancy may increase.
